Directive 2011/65/EU

Directive 2015/863/EU

The Restriction of Hazardous Substances Directive regulates the use of specific substances in electrical and electronic products due to their hazardous effect on the environment. Directive 2011/65/EU has replaced the former directive 2002/95/EC and was set into force as of 8th January 2013. The directive originally listed 6 substances and has been amended by regulation 2015/863/EU as of 4th June 2015, resulting in an extension of the list of hazardous substances by 4 phthalates.

Products of Huba Control are considered as Category 9 products (2011/65/EU, Annex I: Monitoring and control instruments including industrial monitoring and control instruments). Therefore, the regulation 2015/863/EU is applicable for Huba Control products as of July 2021 (as stated in 2015/863/EU, clause (7)).
